ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The successful candidate will be working under the supervision of the Maintenance Manager, Jonathan Lee. Even though the role of <u>Summer Intern</u> will be primarily devoted to the Maintenance Department, it is our goal to allow him/her to experience all facets of the business. They will spend time in our landscape construction department, nursery, and also in the office.

Primary roles of the position will be, but are not limited to:

- 1. Crew laborer and supervision
- 2. Quality control
- 3. Monitor jobs and take note of issues or potential issues in respect to plant/turf problems
- 4. Client interaction
- 5. Fertilizer/Chemical applications
- 6. Equipment operation

NON-ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The role of <u>Maintenance Production Manager</u> is a multi-faceted one where every day will bring a different job or task. They will evolve to the point where he/she will assist in management of landscape maintenance jobs, seasonal color design/selection/installation, assist in designing/estimating enhancement plantings, estimating and sales of maintenance projects, and perform managerial tasks.

SUPERVISORY RESPONSIBILITY

Staff that would be reporting to this position:

- 1. Maintenance Crew Foreman this person guides/manages workflow on job sites
- 2. Maintenance Crew Laborer this person provides manual labor to complete tasks on job sites

EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS

KNOWLEDGE AND SKILL REQUIREMENTS

Strong candidates should either be a recent graduate or currently enrolled in a Horticulture or Landscape Design/Architecture program or related field at an accredited college or university. He/she must possess the ability to perform and/or the desire to learn all maintenance tasks ranging from basic tasks such as operating lawn/garden equipment and weeding to more skillful tasks such as various pruning technique(s) and perennial care in order to train and advise field staff. Other skills such as account management, sales, and estimating are preferred but not mandatory. Spanish speaking is always a plus.

WORKING CONDITIONS

Being an employee in the landscape industry, one has to be able to acclimate to a high-paced working environment. Working hours begin at 6:30a.m. and finish the day around 4:30p.m. depending on work load each day. The <u>Maintenance Production Manager</u> must be able to lift 50+ lbs and be able to withstand bending over for considerable amounts of time.
