## **WATERING INSTRUCTIONS FOR NEW INSTALLATIONS**

(You may count a slow, soaking rainfall of 1" or more as one watering)

### **SPRING and SUMMER INSTALLATIONS**

Deciduous Shrubs, Perennials, and Groundcovers:

- Water around the base of the plant every other day for the first two weeks, until runoff
- Water once a week for the rest of the summer, until runoff

Shade and Ornamental Trees:

- Water around the base of the plant using a slow trickle for 10-15 minutes twice the first week and once the second week until saturated
- Water once every two weeks for the rest of the summer until saturated

Arborvitae, Pines, and Spruce Trees:

- Water around the base of the plant using slow trickle for 10-15 minutes twice the first week and once the second week
- Water once every three weeks for the rest of the summer for Pines and Spruce. Water every two weeks for Arborvitae.

Juniper, Yews and Boxwoods:

- Water once a week for first two weeks, until runoff
- Water every three weeks for the rest of summer

### **FALL INSTALLATIONS**

Deciduous Shrubs, Perennials, and Groundcovers:

- Water around the base of the plant every other day for the first two weeks, until runoff
- Water once per week until the leaves fall off
- Water thoroughly one final time (until the ground is saturated) in November

Shade and Ornamental Trees:

- Water around the base of the plant using a slow trickle for 10-15 minutes twice the first week and once the second week
- Water thoroughly one final time (until the ground is saturated) in November

Arborvitae, Pines, and Spruce Trees:

- Water around the base of the plant using a slow trickle for 10-15 minutes twice the first week and once the second week.
- Water thoroughly one final time (until the ground is saturated) in November

Juniper, Yews and Boxwoods:

- Water once a week for first two weeks, until runoff

*NOTE: Water less during cool, moist periods and more during dry, hot periods.*
